Dear Klein Cain Hurricane Community,

As you are aware, we have been working with the Klein ISD administration and the Department of Defense to secure an AFJROTC Unit at Klein Cain for the 2017-2018 school year. We were able to get our site visit moved from August 2017 to April 20, 2017. The site visit went very well, and we were awarded maximum points for the visit.

Unfortunately, despite the best efforts of all involved, we were not awarded a unit at Klein Cain for 2017-2018. There are an excess number of applications for units to be awarded in the state of Texas and that did not bode well for Klein Cain this year.

We do understand and respect the wishes of our students to participate in such a wonderful program and realize all of the opportunities (e.g. scholarship, appointment possibilities, leadership development, etc.) that are afforded to the students who are involved in JROTC for the entirety of their high school career. That said, we have arranged for any student who selected AFJROTC on their course selection sheets for the 2017-2018 school year to be granted approval to stay at their originally zoned high school (before the Klein Cain attendance zone was in existence).

Please take a moment to review the transfer options outlined below. If you wish to exercise your transfer option and attend Klein High or Klein Oak for 2017-2018, please fill out the transfer form that will be provided by your child's current counselor, and return to your home campus counselor ASAP.

Should you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to reach out to us. We will be happy to provide you with as much information as possible in an effort to assist you in making as informed a decision as possible.

Thank you for your patience and support as we have been navigating our way through this process. We do expect to have a unit at Klein Cain for 2018-2019 and are looking forward to bringing this amazing program to life on our campus soon!

KLEIN CAIN JROTC TRANSFER OPTIONS

1. Klein Cain HS will open with freshmen and sophomore students only. Students who are sophomores and juniors at the conclusion of the 2016 – 2017 school year will remain at their current high school. If transportation is currently provided, it will continue to the current high school for a period of three years beginning with the 2017 – 2018 school year. Transportation to Klein Cain HS will be determined according to the existing district transportation policies.
2. Klein Cain HS will not have a JROTC unit for the 2017-2018 school year. It is anticipated that the campus will be awarded a unit in year two (2018-2019). Therefore, in the school year 2016 – 2017, if an 8th or 9th grade student chose JROTC on their course selection sheet for 2017-2018 and is rezoned to Klein Cain HS for 2017 – 2018, he/she will be granted the option to remain at the current high school.

The option to stay will renew automatically each school year after the initial application. It can be revoked by written request from the parent or guardian by June 8th of each school year. Once revoked, it cannot be reinstated or appealed.

If transportation is currently provided, it will continue to the current high school for a period of three years beginning with the 2017 – 2018 school year.

All transfer students are subject to existing UIL eligibility requirements.
