



Dear Klein Cain High School Advanced Placement students,

Taking the Advanced Placement exam is an important part of all AP courses. Klein Cain High School encourages all students to take the AP exam for each of the AP classes they are taking. Scoring well on an AP exam can often earn students college credit for their high school class, saving a significant amount on tuition.

Klein ISD, along with 14 other school districts across the country, is part of an AP pilot program in the 2017-18 school year. The purpose of this pilot is to help the AP Program understand how free, year-round support and streamlined testing procedures can help improve the AP teaching, learning, and exam administration experience.

This year each AP exam costs \$94 if registration is completed by October 15th. Students currently receiving free/reduced lunch should indicate that when they register on the Total Registration website. After their free/reduced lunch status is verified, they will receive a fee reduction.

During the first few weeks of your AP class, your teacher will set up their class in the pilot AP support system and invite you to join. Joining the class will give you access to free resources and let you indicate whether you're taking the exam.

1. Your AP teacher gives you the "Join Code" for your class.
2. Visit the AP support system website <https://apsupport.collegeboard.org/join> and enter the Join Code. (If you are in the system for the first time, you will need to create an account with your name, password, and email address. We recommend using the same information you used to create your College Board account, if you have one).
3. You will view a welcome video and have an opportunity to help future AP students by sharing thoughts about what it's like to take AP classes.
4. Before October 15th, you must indicate your intent to take the AP exams for each of your courses in the AP pilot program and return your consent form.
5. Students will need to register through www.totalregistration.net/ap/440155. This is the system you will use to pay for your exams. To complete registration, students must answer all of the required questions.

Note: Students may register for exams without making payment at the time of registration, but exams must be paid for by February 20, 2018 at 11:59PM or the exams will be cancelled.



IMPORTANT REMINDER: Make sure that you log on to join each AP class that you are in and submit your testing intentions **BEFORE** you register through “Total Registration” for the exams.

Important Dates:

- October 12 – AP Pilot Consent Form due to your AP teacher.
- October 15- registration deadline in the AP Pilot Program. Exam fee is \$94 per exam.
- October 16-February 19- late registration. Exam fee is \$188/per exam.
- February 20- deadline to pay all exams through Total Registration regardless of the registration balance. The exam will be cancelled if payment is not made by this date. There will be NO cancellation fee if the exam is cancelled **before** this date.
- February 21-25- cancellation fee is \$43/per exam.
- On or after February 26- there will be no refunds. NO EXCEPTIONS!
